Comparison of the Porcelain Cyclone and Porcelain Speedbit

Scodd Industries tungsten carbide bits were specifically designed for drilling quickly and efficiently through porcelain, glass, masonry, and other hard surfaces for a variety of applications. Although they are used for many of the same applications, there are some differences that should be noted (especially speed):
